## City Attorney Klein, County Prosecuting Attorney Favor to Host Big Table Conversation on the State of Domestic Violence in Central Ohio

Conversation will bring together elected officials, law enforcement, advocates, service providers and others to discuss the rise in strangulation and how partners are working together to navigate funding challenges

**COLUMBUS**, **OH**—Columbus City Attorney Zach Klein, County Prosecuting Attorney Shayla Favor, and the Mayor's Office of Violence Prevention will host The Mounting Cost of Domestic Violence, a Big Table conversation to shine a light on domestic violence, the rise in felony strangulation cases seen in Central Ohio, and how civic and community partners are working together to navigate funding challenges at the state and federal levels.
