One Last Mosey Before Hanging Up the Spurs

City Attorney's latest neighborhood documentary highlights the Hilltop

COLUMBUS, OH—In what could be the last of his patented "moseys" before riding off into the sunset, Columbus City Attorney Richard C. Pfeiffer, Jr. released the latest installment of his neighborhood documentary video series.

The new episode of <u>*Moseying with Rick Pfeiffer: Exploring Columbus Neighborhoods*</u> features the Hilltop on Columbus' west side and was shot last year during a time when City Attorney Pfeiffer was contemplating his own political mortality. After 35 years in public office, he ultimately decided not to seek reelection in 2017 and announced that he would retire at the end of his current term on December, 31, 2017.

These ruminations seem to bring added weight to some of the more poignant moments of the documentary, as Pfeiffer visits several Hilltop landmarks, including Camp Chase Cemetery and the location of the former state mental institution.

"I hope these 'moseying' videos inspire others to get out and explore, to learn more about their community and to find common ground with their fellow residents," said City Attorney Richard C. Pfeiffer, Jr. "Even after moving on from public life, I'm sure I'll still be moseying wherever the wandering spirit may lead me."

City Attorney Pfeiffer initiated the Hilltop episode, which is the seventh chapter of the video series, at the invitation of Lisa Boggs, a long-time west side resident and community activist.

Along with Lisa, the Hilltop mosey features Columbus School Board member and director of Our Lady of Guadalupe Center Ramona Reyes, Greater Hilltop Area Commission Chair Jay McCallister, Friends of the Hilltop operations manager Bill Huffman, Ding-Ho Restaurant owner Stephen Yee, Glenwood Community Center manager James Davis, and many others.
